HEINEKEN REGATTA 2011



"Rum, Fun and Sun all in one", that's the catchphrase of the Heineken Regatta and it certainly lives up to its reputation. The Heineken Regatta takes place around the beautiful multi cultural Dutch/French island of St Martin. The regatta is just getting bigger and better every year, the extra day racing created in 2007 was the icing on the cake. The parties are legendary, The Black Eyed Peas, Shaggy, Damien Marley, Jimmy Cliff, have all performed on the beach on one of the largest sound stages in the Caribbean.



For Heineken 2011 we have gone bigger, faster, more luxurious and are offering a VIP regatta experience that you won't find anywhere else. Disco Inferno 3, a CNB Bordeaux 60 is the racing weapon, 60ft of Briand designed elegance, speed and style, add our brand new North racing sails, a carbon 3DL genoa, still on the furler but with state of the art inflatable battens to make it as fast as possible plus our brand new "big boy" asymmetric spinnakers, 320sqm of North Sails power to blast us round the Caribbean sea.

Going faster on the water isn't the end, a big, fast, flash boat needs a super luxury villa and that is what we have for 2011! Sitting on Simpson Bay Lagoon and offering 4 en-suite rooms (3 double & 1 triple) plus a stunning pool and deck to relax on and soothe away the aches and pains of a hard day on the water. We are offering the double rooms in the villa for single or double occupancy but as they are double beds you get the whole room to keep to yourself or share with a sailing or non sailing partner as you choose, rooms are allocated on a first to book first to choose basis so book early to ensure your room.





Your Heineken week on Disco 3 starts with your arrival on Monday 28th February, we then practice Tues and Weds with racing scheduled for Thurs, Fri, Sat & Sun. The first day's racing on Thursday is the Commodores Cup day, a new day added in 2007 for the spinnaker classes only, its a great day comprising of 2 - 3 windward leeward races outside Simpson Bay that will be scored independently of the weekend Heineken Regatta Racing so is a perfect opportunity to put our practice into a real race, a brilliant warm up for the regatta ahead.

Fri, Sat & Sun are the Heineken Regatta races, the first race takes the fleet from Simpson Bay anticlockwise around the whole island, it's a 35nm round trip and you get really close in to the land so you have a perfect opportunity to check out the beautiful scenery while racing hard against some of the best boats the Caribbean has to offer. The finish and the party are back in Simpson Bay, usually a huge Reggae affair on the beach, what a way to round off a perfect day on the water, a rum in your hand and sand between your toes watching the sunset over the Caribbean sea! The next day sees the fleet doing two to three races round the cans, again in the beautiful warm and crystal clear waters off St Martin's South West coast. The finish and the party are in Marigot on the French side, this night is proving to be the best night of all, seafood like you have never tasted and dancing in the streets or Marigot with thousands of other racers until the early hours. Starting off Marigot Bay the last race is back round to the capital Philipsburg before returning to Simpson Bay for a few early evening cold ones. That evening is the final party and prize giving on the beach followed by the big concert with headline band. What a week, it's fun, fun, fun from the moment your plane touches down.

Check out the itinerary for the week.....

Monday 28th February - Arrive on the friendly island of St Maarten, direct flights from Paris or fly from London via the US or Antigua. Evening BBQ at the villa & meet the crew.

Tuesday 1st March – RIB pickup to join Disco3 in Simpson Bay Marina we'll head out on the 9am bridge for a few hours practice and take the 11.30am back in. Lunch then off to the famous Sunset bar for beers and plane spotting, relax on the beach for the rest of the afternoon before heading back to the Villa for another fabulous BBQ Dinner prepared by our gourmet chef, Lizzie.

Wednesday 2nd March – RIB pick up from villa to boat, we'll head out on the 9am bridge for a few hours practice and take the 11.30am back in, giving you the afternoon to enjoy the island, villa and sunshine. Evening is dinner out at Jimbo's, our favourite restaurant, followed by the Soggy Dollar Bar for the Mount Gay Rum Party.

Thursday 3rd March - The Commodores Cup, an 8.30am start gets us out the bridge in time for 2 - 3 Windward Leeward races, a great warm up for the Heineken Regatta, time to get the team work ultra slick and work out those aches, pains and sunburn before the weekend. Evening BBQ at the villa before we head off to the welcome party on Simpson Bay beach.

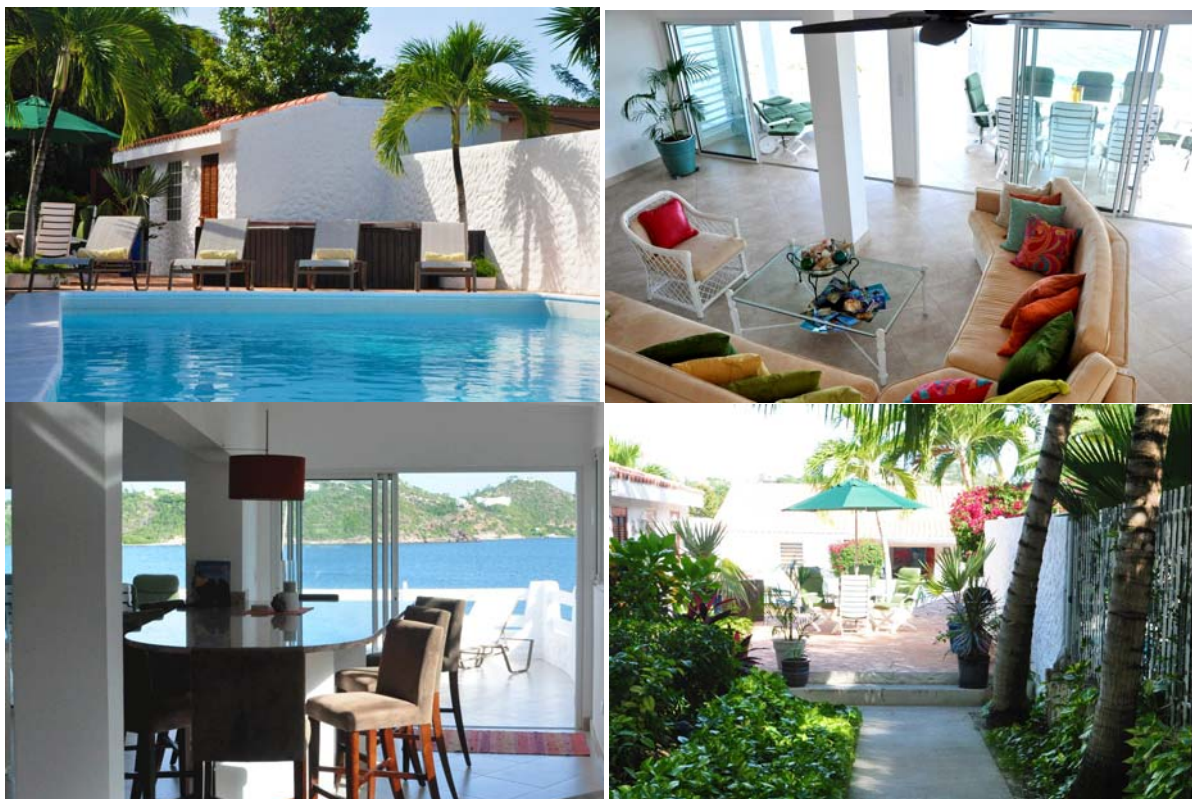
